OVERVIEW

The OWL Bowl is a charity flag football event hosted by the Rice Business Program. The 5th annual, 2019 tournament date is Sunday, November 10th at the Rice University campus. The flag football event will be a great networking opportunity, as well as a great way to support a great cause. We look forward to seeing MBA students from local schools such as University of Houston, University of Texas, and Texas A&M University.

CHARITY

Teams will have the opportunity to compete on behalf of the charity of their choice. The winning team's charity will be the recipient of all donations from teams and individuals raised through the tournament. There is a minimum team donation of \$500 to enter the tournament, but teams are allowed to donate more if desired.

EVENT INFORMATION

The flag football event will take place on Sunday November 10, 2019. Every team will be guaranteed a minimum of two games during the event. The plan is to have one "friendly" game and then start a tournament amongst the participating teams. The event is open to all MBA students (no significant others) and alumni (please reach out).

There is a \$500 entry fee per team, and there is no limit on team rosters. The entry fee covers food and drinks for each team member. Each school will be required to send a roster (see end of document) of each team. Each player will be required to sign an athletic waiver form prior to participating.

Alcohol is allowed on campus at Rice University. No bottles are permitted. Anyone not behaving properly will be asked to leave.

We encourage people to bring their families too. This should be a great event with lots of great people. Bring a lawn chair, a radio, and something to snack on.

GAMEPLAY

Teams will consist of 7 players on the field at a time. Teams must have a minimum of 2 women on the field at all times (you can play more than 2, but not less than 2).

Referees will be provided. Rules are attached in a separate document.

Attire:

- Please wear your school colors and also bring an alternate color t-shirt (White, Black, and Gray are suggested options). If a school has two teams and they play each other, the alternate t-shirt will come in handy.
- All shirts must be tucked in during play.
- No pockets on the pants. This rule is both safety driven and a wardrobe malfunction prevention measure. It will be **enforced**.
- No hats or anything with a hard facing can be worn during gameplay.
- No steel/metal cleats. Plastic cleats are fine.

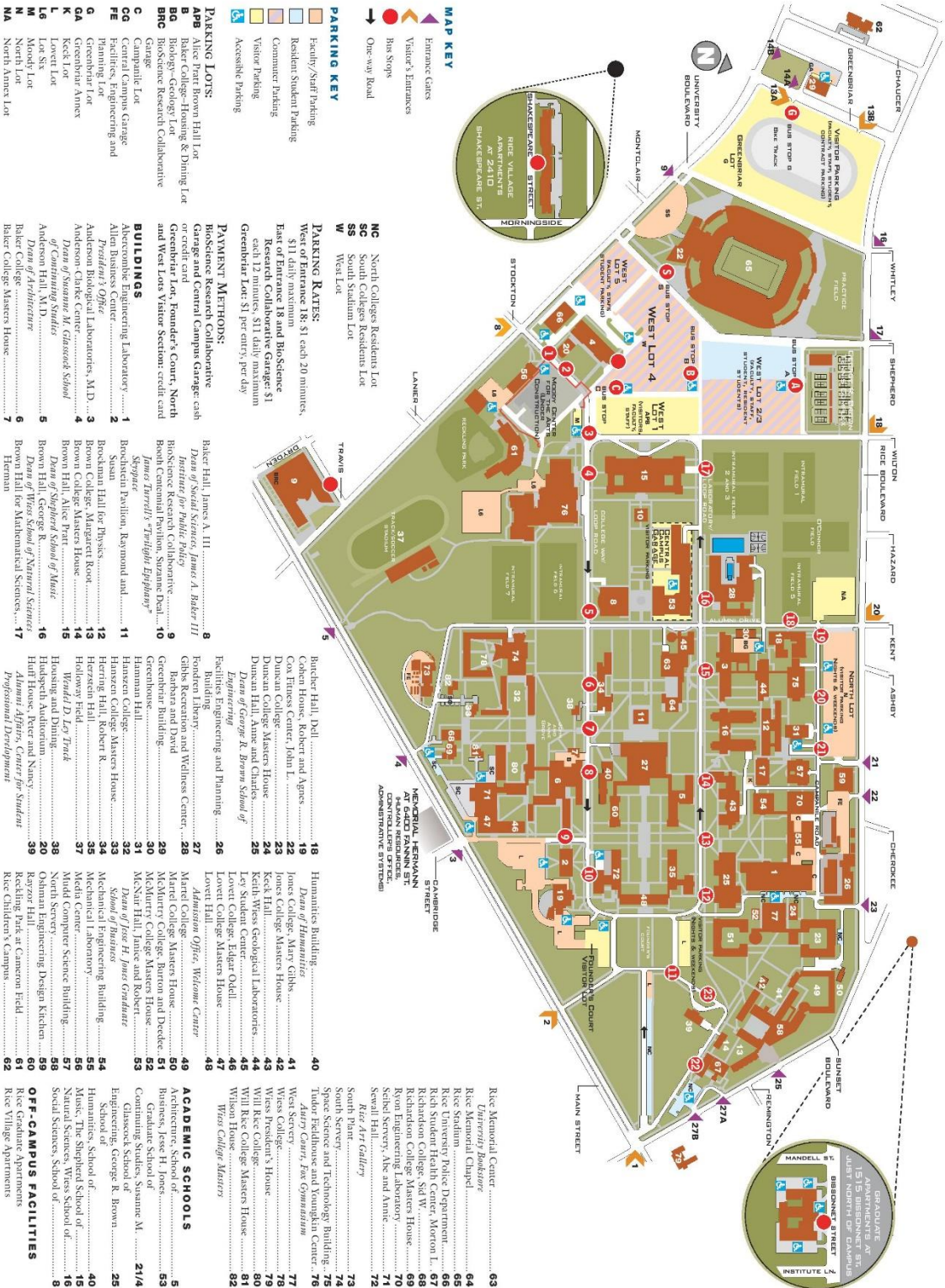
